Placing a Call

Dial an extension number
 Or: Dial the external number required

Call Transfer

- While connected to an outside line, press TRANSFER
- Dial the desired extension number, (700-899)
- Hang up to complete call transfer
 Or: Announce the call, then hang up to complete call
 transfer

External Call Transfer

- While connected to an outside line, press the TRANSFER
- Dial outside number
- Press Send

Call Pick-up

- Press Pick Up Key or *88 to answer an unattended phone ringing
- Press Send

Using Speed Dial Numbers

 Press the <u>Directory</u> Soft Button then press 1 for all contacts or use soft button to search

Ring Type Mode

- Press Menu button Scroll to basic press 4 followed by 1, 2 or 3
- Press Save button

- 2: busy forward

- Press 1 to disable and 2 to delete number

Holding Calls

Press hold button
 To retrieve press flashing green light

Do Not Disturb (DND)


Press Dnd on soft key

Trans/PGM

The **TRANSFER** key is used to **TRANSFER** calls and **PROGRAM** system features on the keyset

Hold/Save
