Placing a Call

- Using the handset:
- Pick up the handset
- Enter the number, and then press the send soft key
- Using the speakerphone:
- With the handset on-hook, press

Call Transfer

- While connected to an outside line, press
 TRANSFER
- Dial the desired extension number, (700-899)
- Hang up to complete call transfer Or: Announce the call, then hang up to complete call transfer

External Call Transfer

- While connected to an outside line, press the TRANSFER
- Dial outside number
- Press Send

Call Pick-up

 Press Pick Up Key or *88 # to answer an unattended phone ringing

Using Speed Dial Numbers

 Press the Directory Soft Button then press 1 for all contacts or use soft button to search

Ring Type Mode

- Press Menu button Scroll to basic press 4 followed by 1, 2 or 3
- Press Save button

Call Forward

- Press Menu scrool to the features

- 2: busy forward
- 3: no answer forward
- Press 1 to disable and 2 to delete number

Do Not Disturb (DND)


Press Dnd on soft key

The TRANSFER key is used to place calls on HOLD, it is also used to confirm the programming of features
